The Governor's Mansion, the official residence of the Governor and First Lady, was designed by Georgia architect A. Thomas Bradbury and completed in 1967. Located in northwest Atlanta on 18 acres of wooded grounds, the 24,000 square-foot Greek Revival style house has 30 rooms. The Mansion's collection of 19th century furniture, paintings and porcelain, maintained by the non-profit organization Friends of the Mansion, make up one of the finest Federal Period collections in the United States.
