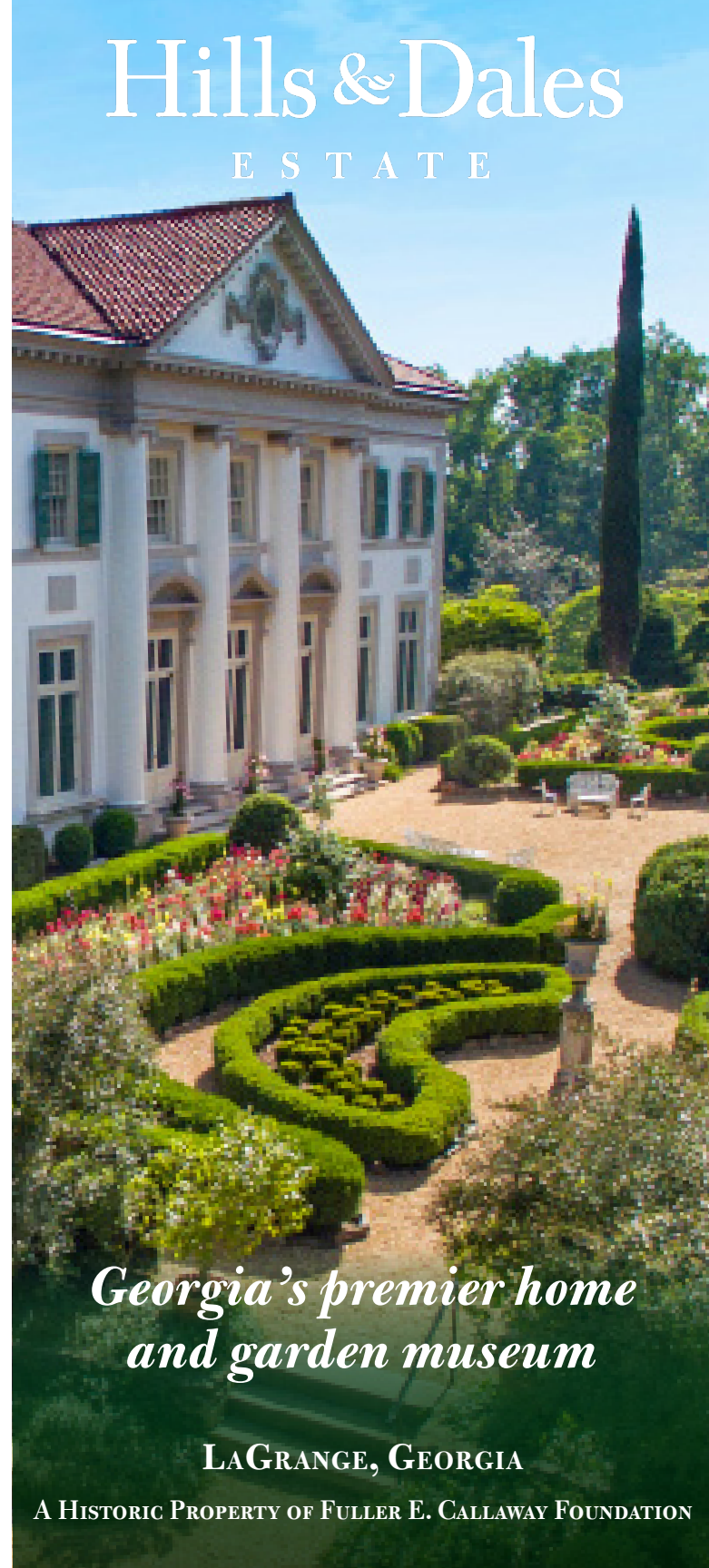
DIRECTIONS

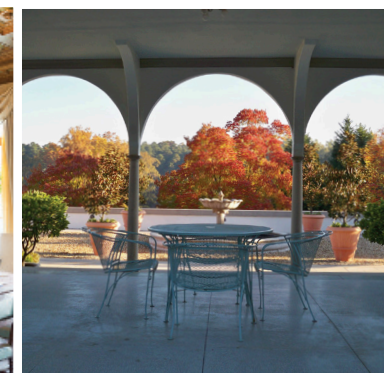
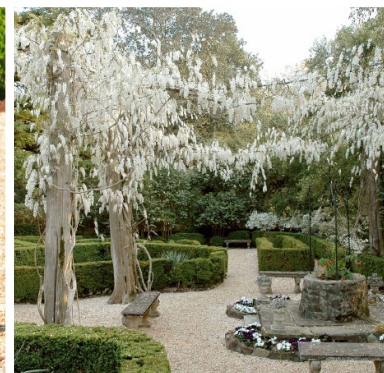
Go and be spellbound by the story of love of three ladies for their garden and the families who called this land their home.
