

# Inspiring appreciation and conservation of the Flint River

Explore the world around you like never before with interactive exhibits and face-to-face encounters with the creatures and fish native to south Georgia.

Located on the banks of the Flint River, the Flint River Quarium tells the story of the Flint River and the blue hole springs that helped create it. Visitors experience the unique ecosystems of the Flint River watershed through a variety of exhibits featuring more than 100 species of native aquatic life. Ongoing programming, such as dive shows, alligator feedings and animal presentations, ensure that every visit has something new to offer.

### **Exhibits**

The 175,000-gallon, 22-foot-deep, open-air Blue Hole is filled with the fish, reptiles and plants found in the Flint River's eco-system. The aviary gives visitors an up-close look at a wide variety of birds found in the surrounding wetland habitat. An interactive children's gallery lets young visitors crawl through a limestone cavern, make their own rivers at a huge sand table and learn how to conserve water with fun computer games.

The three-story tall screen at the Imagination Theater lets you jump into the middle of nature and adventure from your comfy seats. Enjoy a variety of delicious movie treats at the concession counter.
