



Little River Water ~ Trail

Raysville

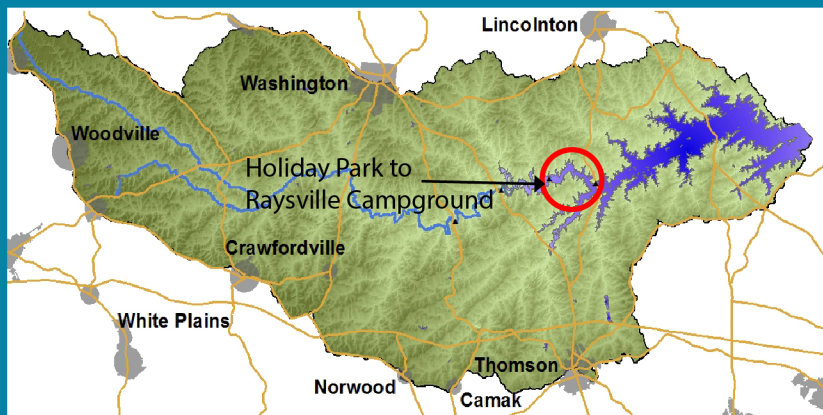
Description: This section of the trail is all lake paddling. Entering and exiting your kayak along most any bank here is possible. The shorelines and islands along this section have interesting features and are fun to explore. One island has a large nest on it made by either an eagle or an osprey. This section is a leisurely 5.5 mile paddle to Raysville Campground. The ramp there is easily spotted next to a long aluminum dock extending out into the lake. The Hwy 43 bridge will be to your west when you see the ramp to your south.

Length: 5.5 miles from Holiday Park Access to Raysville Campground Access

Difficulty: Class I - Flatwater Suitable for Beginners

Paddling Time: 3 hours

Note: Great section for fishing along the crooked shoreline on both sides and around the islands. This section has some powerboat traffic but is no problem if you stay near to a shoreline.
