The Jarrell family settled in Jones County, Georgia, in 1820. For the next 150 years they drew sustenance, and sometimes prosperity, from this begrudging land. Their ingenuity and tenacity are evident in all they accomplished here.

- *The Jarrell 1920 House, their third existing home here, is an 1850s style plantation country house with walls and ceilings of rare heart pine — felled, milled, and assembled by Dick Jarrell and his sons.*
- *Large, cozy bedrooms for one or two people, Sunday through Thursday, are \$140 per night, with full breakfast in the dining room.*

The two-night weekend (\$250) includes Saturday

continental breakfast, and Sunday breakfast in the dining room.

Guests receive free tours of the Jarrell 1920 House and adjoining Jarrell Plantation State Historic Site, both in the National Registry of Historic Places.

Return to another age. Walk through 150 years of Georgia and Jarrell family history — each step a witness to the character that made our nation great.
