- **Born into an Enslaved Family**
- **Master Craftsman/Bridge Builder**
- **Purchased Freedom in 1842**
- **Served as a Voter Registrar and State Representative in Alabama**
- **Voted into the Alabama Engineers Hall of Fame**
- **Resided in LaGrange, Georgia, with his family**
- **Buried in LaGrange at Mulberry Street Cemetery**
