
A Man Ahead of His Time Horace King

- Born into an Enslaved Family
- Master Craftsman/Bridge Builder
- Purchased Freedom in 1842
- Served as a Voter Registrar and State Representative in Alabama
- Voted into the Alabama Engineers Hall of Fame
- Resided in LaGrange, Georgia, with his family
- Buried in LaGrange at Mulberry Street Cemetery
