





MONROE COUNTY History & Genealogy

Monroe County's history dates back over 200 years. Housed inside the red brick Victorian Train Depot along the Norfolk-Southern Railway Track, the Monroe County Historical Society is tasked with the preservation and interpretation of that rich history, and has transformed the c. 1899 depot into a dedicated museum and genealogical center. Its collections include a print stand once used by the author of *Uncle Remus*, Joel Chandler Harris, and a cotton gin similar to that of Eli Whitney.




