The Bradley Olmsted Garden contains a wide variety of trees and blooms, including many that are indigenous to the South. Several of the original plantings from the 1900s can be seen, along with new plantings that have been added to fit within the original plan. There is always something in bloom in our garden, which both garden novices and experts will appreciate and enjoy in the picturesque vistas created by the renowned Olmsted Brothers firm for original home owner W.C. Bradley.

Enjoy the nature trails running through the garden leading to several key elements, such as a pool house, grotto, and natural spring ravine that are original to the garden.
