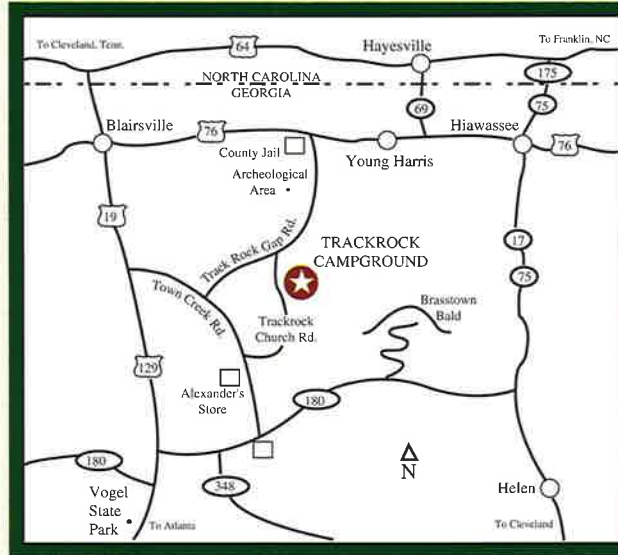
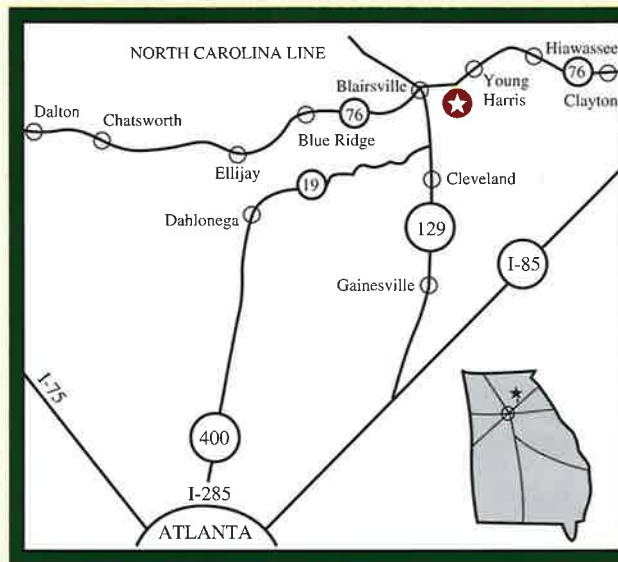

How long since you've been on an old-fashioned hayride? Or picked sun-ripened berries by the bucketful? Or curled up on the porch swing to finish that novel? Too long? Then the Alexanders welcome you to Trackrock Campground and Cabins in the shadows of North Georgia's tallest mountains.

Trackrock is a 300 acre paradise of meadows, hayfields, and woodlands within a challenging hike of Brasstown Bald, Georgia's highest peak. Completely isolated from all other commercial developments, the property is bordered on three sides by National Forest. Great care is taken to preserve the natural environment. Wildlife, flowers, and flowering shrubs are abundant.

There are 90 level, shaded, uncrowded campsites—take your pick—and each site has water and electricity. Several sites are designed for pull-through parking, and over one-half have sewer connections. Central bath houses in the camping area are kept spotless and are equipped with hot showers.

One and two bedroom cabins are available for non campers. The cabins are fully furnished and have covered porches, picnic tables and grills. The office and recreation building called "The Talking House" because guests just naturally seem to congregate there in the evenings to talk and to make new friends. The office also houses a laundry facility and offers ice, firewood, and LP gas.

What is there to do? Swim or fish in the four-acre spring-fed lake, or sun on the white sand beach. Take a horseback ride over beautiful mountain trails and lush meadows. Hike along broad trails and lush meadows. Climb aboard the wagon for a memorable hayride in the evening. Have the time of your life at a local fair or music festival. See top-name country performers at the Georgia Mountain Fairgrounds, or Georgia's official state play, "The Reach of Song." Shop for local crafts or go antiques. Send the kids to the large playground while you relax in a rocking chair on the porch. Or simply enjoy the quiet and rustic charm of Trackrock.

Trackrock Campground and Cabins is conveniently located nine miles from Blairsville, near Trackrock Gap Archaeological area, Vogel State Park, Richard Russell Scenic By-Way, Brasstown Bald, and only minutes from Lake Chatuge. Within a 45 minute drive is Alpine Helen, Historic Dahlonega, gem mining in Franklin, NC, and tubing or whitewater activities.
